

Temperature and Rapid Antigen Test Record Sheet

- 1. Parents/Guardians should take their children's temperature before going to school. If the temperature is over 99.5°F or 37.5°C, he/she should not attend school and should consult a doctor promptly.
- 2. Any accompanying adults and their child should complete a Rapid Antigen Test daily before arriving for any ESF Sports and Language Activities. No one will be admitted to campuses without declaring a negative result from a RAT taken that day. If tested positive, they must not go to attend the class and should inform their educators of their positive results as soon as possible and stay at home.
- 3. Parents/Guardians should record their children's temperature and sign on the record sheet daily. The record sheet should be returned to class teacher/coach for checking.
